On February 10, 2009, the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act (CPSIA) went into effect. This law prohibits the sale of children's products that contain lead. As a result, youth powersport products, including minicycles and ATVs plus a wide range of parts and accessories, have been removed from showroom floors and are no longer available. Although well intentioned, the CPSIA as applied to youth powersports—a group of products that does not cause measurable increases in blood lead levels—has resulted in the unintended but complete gutting of our youth market.
